Checklist of Birds of Kibale Forest

Introduction

This checklist originates from a list compiled by Joseph Skorupa (1983). It has been update and revised by Leon Bennun (1997) and Anthony Kuria (2005).

Records of some of the transient and accidental birds are included, as well as resident and regular migrants. Many of the species listed are not true forest species, but will be found in other habitats that occur within or immediately adjacent to Kibale Forest National Park. At least 319 bird species in 56 families are included.

Taxonomy and nomenclature follows the standard 1996 East Africa list published by the Ornithological Subcommittee of the East Africa Natural History Society. Names may differ from those in the main field guides. However, with updated field guides for the region now available, it is fairly easy to find species. References used include:

Where appropriate, species dependence on forests is indicated following Bennun, L., Dranzoa, C. and Pomeroy, D. (1996, *The forest birds of Kenya and Uganda. JEANH 85: 23-48*):

“FF species (forest specialist) are the ‘true’ forest birds, characteristic of the interior of undisturbed forest. They may persist in secondary forest and forest patches if their particular ecological requirements are met. Where they do occur away from the interior, they are usually less common. They are rarely seen in non-forest habitats. Breeding is almost invariably within forests.

F species (forest generalists) may occur in undisturbed forest but are also regularly found in forest strips, edges and gaps. They are likely to be commoner there and in secondary forest than in the interior of intact forest. Breeding is typically within forest.

f species (forest visitors) are birds which are often recorded in forest, but are not dependent upon it. They are almost always more common in non-forest habitats, where they are most likely to breed.”

Species migration status given represent Afrotropical migrant (**AM**), Malagasy migrant (**MM**) and Palaearctic migrant (**PM**). Where these letters are in lower case-am, mm or pm- migrants of that category occur alongside resident or non-migrant individuals.

Any new species for the list should be reported to the Makerere University Institute of Environment and Natural Resources’ Bird Atlas Project (P O Box 10066, Kampala) with full supporting details.
